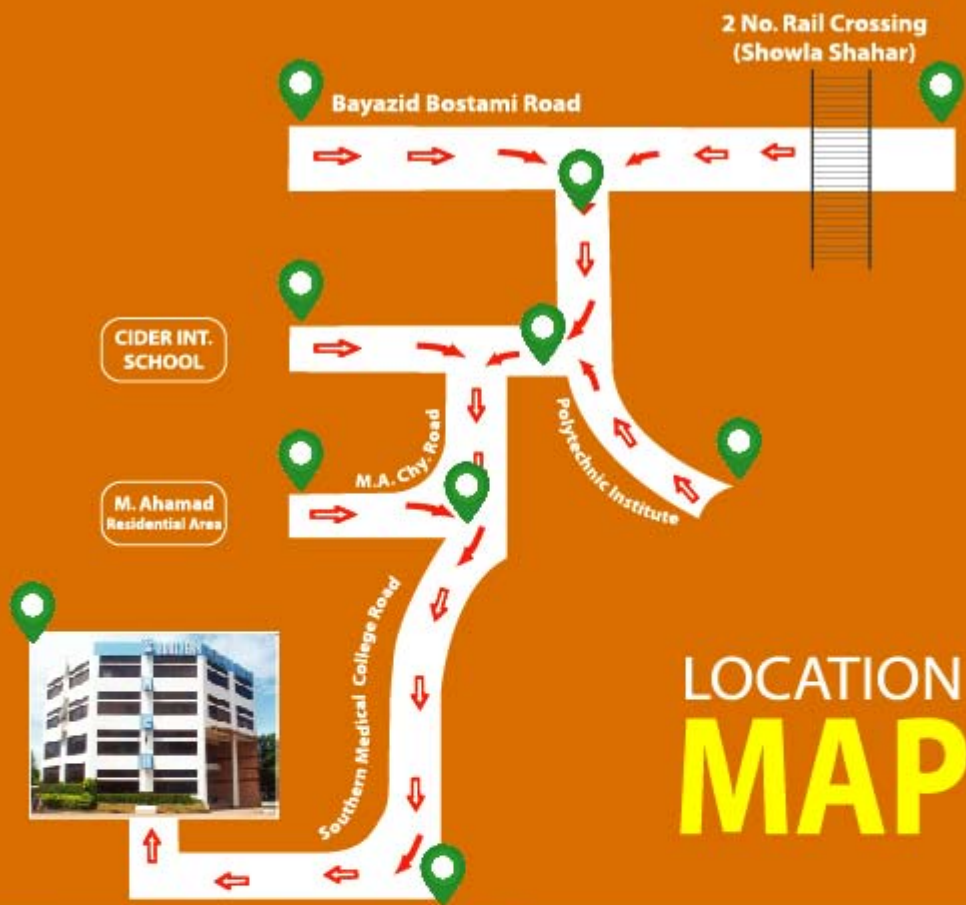

## ADMISSION

### Eligibility of Applicants:

As per prescribed criteria's by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of Bangladesh.

### Admission & Selection Procedures:

Successful candidates selected by the Directorate of Health Services (DG Health) through their competitive exam, will be eligible for admission in SMCH. The final selection of the students is made by a selection committee formed by the Academic Council. They will follow the Merit List of "National admission result". Selected candidates will have to undergo a medical test (by the authorized SMCH doctors) to prove their physical competency.

## FOREIGN STUDENTS

Foreign Students may be admitted upto 45% of the total seat as per rules. The students will have to submit permission from their respective government. The interested applicants must fulfill the following criteria of eligibility for admission.

1. Applicants must have passed qualifying examinations i.e. 12th grade (10+2=12 years) of schooling at a public school/ board/ college or passed an examination in any foreign country which is recognized by the Government of Bangladesh as equivalent to the Higher Secondary Certificate Examination.
2. Applicants must have passed Higher Secondary Certificate Examination or equivalent examinations with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as their major/ compulsory subjects.
3. Applicants must have obtained marks that is equivalent to GPA 9.00 in Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) examinations or in equivalent examination respectively and have had GPA 3.50 separately. Tribals (all) non-tribals from Chattogram Hill Tracts will have to have at least GPA 8.00 in SSC and HSC or equivalent examinations. GPA 3.50 in biology in HSC or equivalent examination is requires for all applicants both local and International.
4. All academic certificate must be transferred to Bangladesh standard (through collection of Equivalence Certificate from DGHS Dhaka, Bangladesh) & Student Visa formalities through embassy of Bangladesh.
5. Application should be submitted in SMCH prescribed forms. Attested copies of certificates and mark sheets etc. have to be furnished along with the application. All certificates and mark-sheets must be attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the respective country of the applicant's academic institution. No application will be accepted without such attestation.
6. The successful applicants will require to produce all academic certificates and mark-sheets in original during their admission.

## CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

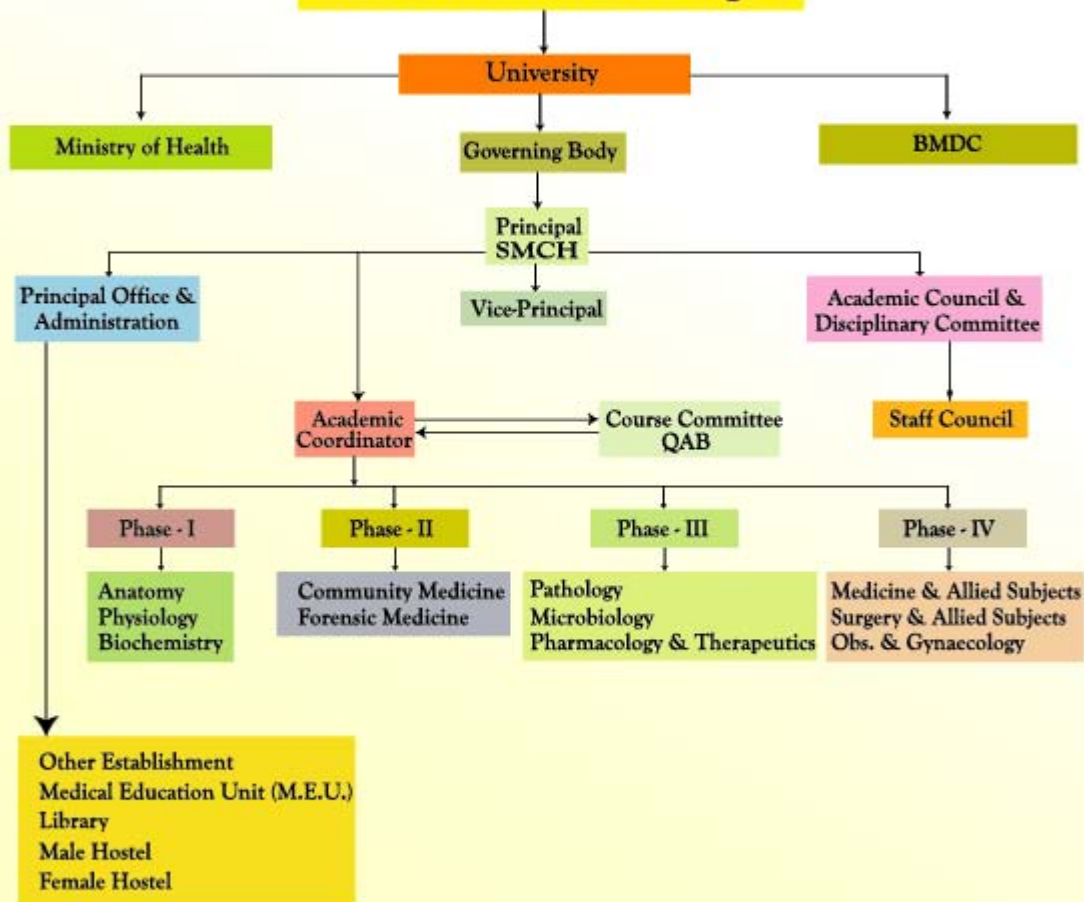

### INSTRUCTION TO THE STUDENTS

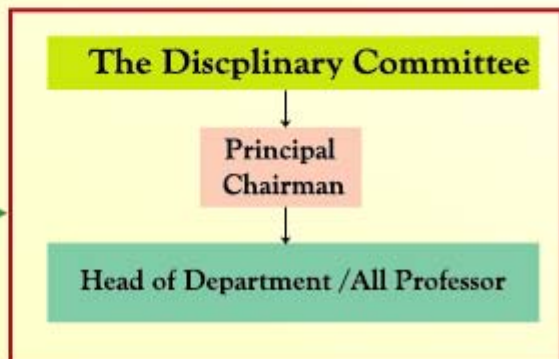
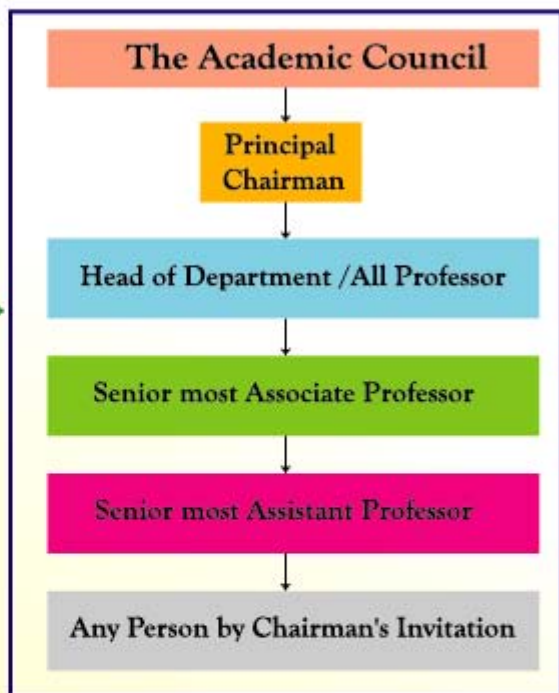
1. All students are to carry their identity cards when in the college.
